Board of Education Regular Meeting – Thurs., November 2, 2023

The board took action on the following:

- In honor of National American Indian and Alaska Native Heritage Month, the board adopted a resolution honoring the contributions of Native Americans.
- The board adopted a resolution Declaring that Climate Change is One of the Most Pressing Crises of Our Time; the District Has an Obligation and a Responsibility to Prepare Students for a World Shaped by the Degradation of Our Environment; and Set Forth a Commitment to Develop and Support Existing Curricula and Practices to Establish a Minimum Standard of Climate Literacy for its Students. This resolution was presented by Samohi Team Marine students and our district's Sustainability Coordinator.
- The board adopted a resolution recognizing United Against Hate Week: November 13-19, 2023.

The board discussed the following:

- Staff presented updates to the policies, regulations, and exhibits related to: Complaints
 Against Employees, Complaints Concerning Instructional Materials, Uniform Complaint
 Procedures, and Williams Uniform Complaint Procedures. These changes align with new
 laws and meet the Federal Program Monitoring requirements.
- Staff and students from Samohi's Team Marine presented a new policy regarding Environmental Education for the board to consider. This policy coincided with the Climate Literacy the students and staff presented earlier in the meeting.
- Staff presented a policy and regulation regarding Physical Education and Activity for the board to consider adopting. The language in this policy meets the Federal Program Monitoring requirements.
