## The board took action on the following:

- As part of its annual organizational meeting each December, the Board of Education elected a new President and Vice President. Congratulations to Jen Smith, who was elected to serve as Board President, and Jon Kean, who was elected to serve as Board Vice President, for 2024!
- The board approved the schedule of Board of Education meetings for 2024-25.
- The board approved the 2022 audits for the district as well as for Measures "R," "BB," "ES," "SMS," and "M."
- The board approved the First Interim Report for the 2023-24 budget. Every school district is required to show evidence to its County Board of Education that it can meet its financial obligations for the remainder of the current fiscal year and for the two fiscal years after that. The First Interim Report satisfies this requirement.
- The board approved an MOU between The Shark Fund in Malibu and the Dick and Arlene Van Dyke Endowment for the Visual and Performing Arts with the proposed goal of strengthening the Visual and Performing Arts program across all SMMUSD schools in Malibu for generations to come.

## **Special Note:**

- The board approved the appointment of Ms. Daniela Wiener as the new Principal of McKinley Elementary School. She had been serving as the Assistant Principal of McKinley and Grant Elementary Schools.
- In honor of National Inclusive Schools Week, Lincoln Middle School emphasized the importance and benefits of a culture of inclusion. They shared how the Peer Connections program at their school fosters meaningful relationships among neurodiverse and neurotypical students.
