Teacher Role

- Use complex and appropriate text.
- 2. Read the text multiple times and analyze prior to instruction.
- 3. Anticipate and prepare for potential challenges the text may present for certain students.
- 4. Generate text-dependent questions that allow students to support their understanding of (a) what the text says, (b) how it says it, and (c) what the text means.
- 5. Facilitate and monitor complex and rigorous conversations that focus on the deeper meaning of the text.
- 6. Connect reading activities back to the selected text.

Student Role

- 1. Read the text more than once.
- 2. Persevere while reading and developing a better understanding of a complex text.
- 3. Analyze the text for (a) what the text says, (b) how it says it, and (c) what the text means.
- 4. Use evidence from the text to ask and answer text-dependent questions.
- 5. Actively participate in rigorous conversations that focus on the deeper meaning of the text.
