- Initial Findings (slides 13-20)
 - Celebrations:
 - Perseverance with academics through COVID
 - CAST: (Exceed/Met Standard) Grades 5, 8, 11, and 12 55%
 - ❖ ELPAC (Level 4): 40%
 - Fastbridge aReading:> 56% College Pathway
 - Fastbridge aMath: 54% College Pathway
 - Close alignment between CAASPP and Star in both ELA and Math (Exceed/Met Standard)
 - ➤ ELA CAASPP: 75% Star Reading 70%
 - Math CAASPP: 58% Star Math 52%
 - Growth Areas:
 - Participation rates vary with Fastbridge and Star Assessment data (declines in spring)
 - Overall Math performance continues to be an area of need
 - Significant % of African-American/Black student did not meet standards in ELA or Math
 - Significant % of Latinx students did not meet standards in ELA or Math
