Teachers measure how much linguistic support is needed, and how well students express ideas clearly and communicate using academic language.			
Parent Opinion and Consultation	Parents and/or guardians meet with school administrators and staff to review student data and provide input. Secondary students are encouraged to attend reclassification meetings whenever possible.
