2. What **ethical** issues did you select to focus on, and why did you choose this as your focus?
3. What **impact** do you want to have on someone who studies/analyzes your art piece, what do you hope that they learn from it?

Ethics: What dilemmas or controversies are involved in this topic?

Point of View: How do different people see this situation?

Impact: How does water influence living things and the land, and vice-versa? What are the effects of our water usage on fresh water, and or the water cycle?
