III. UPDATE: Special Education Director, Deanna Sinfield

- 3/2 Denna hosting a meeting for parents to give input about what they would like to see for next year programming. Programs that are doing well but not hitting kids that need it, what can we do for programing to reach more kids long term?
- English Language Learners: how to identify if a student needs special ed or just more
 English language development; LPAC test yearly: gen ed + special ed to make sure
 accommodations are being met so kids have the opportunity to reclassify, Vcalps
 administered by special Ed teacher. Both are state and federally mandated
- Deanna is presenting to the Board in March
- SEDAC Co-chairs Deanna Sinfield and Payal Maniar are on Superintendent's budget cuts committee

IV. UPDATE: BOARD LIAISON Jon Kean

- SAMOHI event last week: last beam of steel on the discovery building, will be in it for Fall 2021 academic year; flex space, humanities classes, lower level tbc, parking
- Mural on Lincoln/ Ocean Park: how public art can serve a bigger role in the community
- Superintendent budget committee starting 2/5/20: teachers union: table agreement the unit members have to approve it
- SEDAC members inquired about subsidized housing for SMMUSD teachers. SMMUSD has 1400 staff members: if we get 100 units that would help.
- Dr. Drati budget cuts committee: examine the function of what we have to find better ways to provide services

- Some cuts made TY for 2021 school year that don't need the committee: some through attrition, some through operating inefficiencies (overstaff or duplication of jobs)
- 3/15: pink slips notice: notice that your job MAY be cut- not definite, based on seniority; last in first out
- Committee will work on '21-'22 school years; every department has to be reviewed: leases, buildings, staff, programming etc...
- Student pop +5%, staff +9%, declining enrollment
- o Superintendent will make recommendations, school board will vote on it
- Anything written into your IEP has to happen, it's a federal law, but there are lots of ways to implement
- V. DISCUSSION: 2019-20 Charges: presented last month; will be following up monthly through June
 - a. Charge 1: Parent Portal
 - Timing on website: March- April: just have to tell the person what we want on it
 - Deanna to review with a couple of SEDAC members the layout of the new site
 - SEDAC docs need to be scanned and uploaded; need to revisit once Deanna is ready
 - b. Charge 2: Transition Plan
 - Deanna to review: some SEDAC recs are parallel to what teachers are asking for, some
 of the ideas are on point with suggestions
 - Read out in April to see where we need to fill holes
 - "SAMOHI experience": programming piece is still not available: Denna meeting with transition teachers next week, looking at some of our programs and repurposing: taking what we have and utilizing it better
 - Need notes from Jaimie about the specific ask so it is documented in the transition: specific pull out for special Ed in the SAMOHI experience: that is the only info you get on special ed. What does the special ed programming look like from the presentation from 1/27/20? Hard to know what is happening in practice, Deanna to get a copy of the presentation
 - c. New Charges for 2019-20 School Year: communications calendar; information architecture
 - Structure of parent portal: how you organize the content on the site will determine what assets get used, Need for Use cases, Deanna needs on the site: special Ed 101, Child Find, etc..
