B. MES Mascot Selection: analyze data and if ready, cast votes:

1. PTA is asking for mascot determination ASAP to maximize effectiveness of critical October fundraiser

2. Survey Data on Mascot:

a. Student survey results: Five classes had sea lion as number one pick. Three classes had sea star as number one pick. Other animals that were chosen the favorite in only one class were stingray, jellyfish, garibaldi, and octopus. Shrimp got second place in three classes. So, picks were: sea lion, sea star, octopus, and shrimp in that order.

b. Parent and Staff Survey: 46 electronic surveys were submitted. 37 parents and 9 staff gave input (80%/20%). The Sea Lion and then the Sea Star were the top picks.

C. Manage the School Improvement Plan (a.k.a Single Plan for Student Achievement)

1. This is the first year of implementation of the strategies for this goal for MES. An annual review will inform 20-21 SPSA.

D. Manage/Update the “Safe School Plan”

1. Raptor system is up and Running at MES - Celebrate!
2. Read and review current plan reflecting input and updates by Chris Hertz
3. Establish the Traffic Safety Committee (suggest names for appointments) with suggested goals as follows:
 - a. Review Traffic Zones/Plan: Is is working? Is compliance realistic? Do parents understand it?
 - b. Determine if rules on distributed 3 pp. traffic plan with map contradict posted signage
 - c. Determine if SMMUSD is in compliance with Malibu Planning Commission’s requirements for approval of 9000ft2 additional buildings? Is this technically MES (other than public relations) or district’s burden? <https://www.malibucity.org/AgendaCenter/ViewFile/Item/3697?fileID=8010>.
 - d. Recommend productive system for logging concerns and observations
 - e. Propose consequences to unsafe driving or violations - what is enforceability?
 - f. Review after school pick up procedure
 - g. Research Safe Passage and Safe Routes to School programs and potential collaboration with city
 - h. Advocate for safety goals as determined by ME SSC via Malibu City Council & SMMUSD (e.g. crossing guard, paint on curbs, signage changes, speed survey, speed indicator signs, cross walk).
 - i. Request follow up traffic study by engineering firm to be presented to ME SSC
4. Establish Safety Committee -suggest names for appointment: members of council, the community, and law enforcement with suggested goals as follows:
 - a. Communicate with MHS and Webster Elementary’s Site Council’s Safety Committees
 - b. Communicate with B&G Club of America re: goals for campus safety concerns and improvements
 - c. Communicate with Wellness Center to learn how to support mental health of students
 - d. Advocate for safety goals as determined by ME SSC via Malibu City Council & SMMUSD (e.g. dedicated officer at MHS who can respond to any school?)
 - e. Follow up on proposed safety upgrades: find out when cameras go in (perimeter fence is vulnerable and impossible to monitor without someone sitting along fence)
