## 3rd - 5th Grade Sample Schedule

#### Summary of Model

- An AM/PM Model, split by grade level band.
- TK/K/1/2 have on-campus learning in the AM and live zoom in the PM.
- 3/4/5 are reversed and have live zoom in the AM and on-campus learning in the PM.
- The home group has asynchronous learning when their class is on campus, and then join their classmates and teacher for the other half of the day on Zoom.
- All returning students in a class come at the same time (whole class).
- Classes are held predominantly outside- This and small class sizes allows the whole class to come at once while maintaining social distancing of 6 feet.
- Each time block would be approximately 2.75 hours totaling 11 hours a week on-campus (meets MOU requirement)
- Teachers, Special Ed, and Intervention, may also invite individual or small groups of students on-campus for intervention or specialized services.
- Wednesday is Zoom for all students 8:30-10:30am and asynchronous learning 10:30-1:35pm

Our plan expands upon our original Distance Learning Plus philosophy, logistics, and core components. Specifically, our plan meets the same amount of time on campus as other models while also meeting McKinley's "Key 3" Guiding Philosophy:

**1. Equity-** 35% of students are not returning to campus. In a traditional split class AM/PM model, or a split week model, the group staying home would attend a District academy separate from the school, or do predominantly asynchronous learning. Our model allows us to keep our school family together, and considers all students. Our home group gets to stay with their current teacher and classmates on Zoom for continuity of learning, and for their emotional well-being and that of their peers.

**2. Healing Transition-** 71% of students are returning predominantly for social-emotional connections. We recognize that the on-campus experience will be different from regular school, and we want the transition back to campus to be joyful and for students to feel safe. Therefore, the on-campus time will focus on physical and social emotional health and enrichment with similar opportunities provided asynchronously to the home group. Our model also minimizes disruption and potential additional trauma in the case of student or class quarantine. In addition, our model offers more live direct instructional time with the teacher by combining live Zoom with on-campus learning opportunities so the amount of direct instruction and cooperative learning is maximized.

**3. Health and Safety-** Our plan prioritizes health and safety by taking advantage of our large outdoor campus space and small class sizes by having the majority of our learning outside. Half the student population is on campus at a time (in grade level bands) to allow for schoolwide social distancing. Also with a AM/PM model our part-time classified staff (IAs and Campus Monitors) can be distributed so that we are fully staffed throughout the day to maximize supervision and safety.
