- What is being done to support their EL student during parent teacher conference
- How do we support students that are classified as EL but may not need EL support but instead need support with special education.
- Some parents move to a different school or do not indicate another language spoken at home because they don't want the testing that comes from being designated as EL
- How do we support students that are classified as EL but may not need EL support but instead need support with special education.
- Parent shared that speaking and listening has been easier for her child but the reading and writing
 has not been as easy. Parent believes that more work can be done at home
- How do we foster the social aspect of our students at school
 - Parents suggested various activities that helped their children such as sports, playing at the park, play dates with class mates, before and after school activities through CREST or Boys and Girls CLub

Elena reported that teachers now have Benchmark (an additional EL tool) that came in at the beginning of the year and they have received training - this will be used as an additional support for EL students in the class
