We will work together to create a solid foundation for our students so that they can become self-directed learners, collaborative teammates, critical thinkers, and responsible citizens. Finally, we will continue to offer intervention services through Special Education, counseling sessions, and Tier II and III programs, as necessary.

We would like to thank you for "attending" our Back to School Night last Thursday. Our staff felt it was important to connect with families *before* the start of this unique school year. You should have received an overview of the instructional program, including initial schedules and expectations, for the start of the year. It was fun to visit all of the virtual classrooms and see our parents' and students' getting to know their new learning community!
