PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE:

Dear Webster Parents,

We hope that you and your families are well. In the midst of an unprecedented summer, our wish is that you found time to unplug and connect with each other in safe ways. We are excited to start our new school year even if it is in an untraditional way.

It has been a very busy week of preparing for the 20-21 school year. Teachers met this week to collaborate and develop schedules that adhere to the distance learning guidelines established by our district Teaching and Learning Council. Today the board of education will vote to adopt the Distance Learning Expectations outlined in the SMMCTA (teacher union) MOU and the 2020-21 SMMUSD school calendar. I encourage you attend the meeting.

Last Spring, we abruptly moved into distance learning when schools closed due to the covid-19 pandemic. What we initially thought would be a two-week closure lasted until school closed. Through that experience we learned a lot about what would be best for our students. We surveyed Webster parents and received feedback through our district wide survey of parents and staff. Below are the most common feedback areas and how we have addressed concerns and adjusted our fall distance learning program.

- 180 instructional minutes in TK/kindergarten.
- 230 instructional minutes in grades 1 to 3, inclusive
- 240 instructional minutes in grades 4 to 12, inclusive

*Education Code Section 43503 requires that distance learning include "daily live interaction." Daily live interaction is two-way communication between a certificated employee and student each instructional day, at the actual time of occurrence. Daily live interaction is required for every student with both a certificated employee and their student peers. In particular, English learners, and students with special needs benefit from daily oral language development opportunities. Examples of daily live interaction include in-person and virtual communication or interactions, including but not limited to synchronous online instruction (per statute) and phone calls where both parties communicate at the time of occurrence. One-way communication, including voicemails, emails, or print materials, is not considered a live interaction.

- Revised district calendar. See the <u>Superintendent's message</u> about this. Board of Education will decide on August 13 if students will now start the school year on Monday, August 24th.

- Distance Learning Parent Handbook: The district will provide parents/staff. It will include topics such as: Attendance, Student expectations, Devices and internet access, Netiquette, learning platforms, Child care / child supervision, Food services, and learning support.

Please continue to exercise patience with Webster Elementary as we roll-out the 20-21 academic school year. Trust that we are working tirelessly to provide a robust and thoughtful learning experience for your children. I know you are eager to see the specific schedules, and we want to provide them to you! But we also need time to develop, plan and iron out the specifics. Our teachers do not actually begin school (by contract) until August 17th!

<u>So, what can I share now?</u> I can provide you a school-wide schedule for distance learning. This will help you see how the day will be generally formatted. Some noteworthy observations and our rationale:

- 1. We wanted to preserve the mornings when our students are most alert and ready to learn! All SMMUSD elementary schools will begin at 8:30 a.m. and hold teacher professional meetings in the afternoon. At Webster, we changed our late start Wednesday to an early release Monday. (Just during DL.)
- 2. We agreed upon common instructional block start times consistent across the school to support families with children in multiple grades.
- 3. We agreed upon a common lunchtime throughout the entire Malibu Pathway, so that families can enjoy lunch with one another.

Meal service: Children enrolled in any SMMUSD school or program will be able to pick up free breakfast and lunch from 8:00 to 10:00 a.m. Monday-Friday at the following schools: Santa Monica High School, McKinley Elementary, Will Rogers Learning Community in Santa Monica and Webster Elementary in Malibu. SMMUSD families may go to any of these schools even if not enrolled there. All students under the age of 18 will be served. A parent or guardian must be present, except high school students may participate on their own. We are providing grab-

and-go bagged meals. If you or your child are sick, do not come to school. **This will continue** through the summer. School year breakfast pick-up times will be adjusted.
