SMMUSD Student Meal Service Continues During Summer

The Santa Monica-Malibu Unified School District announced plans to continue to provide breakfast and lunch to all students under the age of 18, during the summer. Service is Monday through Friday from 8 - 10 a.m. at four schools: Santa Monica High School, McKinley Elementary, Will Rogers Learning Community in Santa Monica and Webster Elementary in Malibu. Meals will not be served on July 3, 2020.

SMMUSD families may go to any of these schools even if not enrolled there. All students under the age of 18 will be served grab-and-go bagged meals. A parent or guardian must be present, except high school students may participate on their own.

If you or your child are sick, do not come to school.

Rogers, McKinley and Webster pick up will be at the front of the school, either right out front, or in the usual drop off/ pick up drive through. Samohi pick up will be at the 7th and Michigan gate.

"We understand that many of our families are struggling right now and these meals are providing an important service," Superintendent Dr. Ben Drati said. "We are working to support our families during this difficult time, including over the summer."
