## Board of Education Regular Meeting – Thurs., April 22, 2021

### **The board took action on the following:**

- The board adopted a resolution honoring Week of the Young Child: April 11-17, 2020. The resolution highlighted our State Preschool and Seaside Programs, as well as our after-school programs, and called on the residents of our community to support the needs of our young children.
- The board adopted a resolution honoring Adult Ed Week: April 6-10, 2020. The resolution highlighted the many services provided by our adult ed program, including English as a Second Language and Citizenship courses, Adult Basic Education, High School Diploma and High School Equivalency (HSE)/Alternative classes, and GED completion.
- The board adopted a resolution honoring Dolores Huerta, arguably the most prominent Mexican-American female labor leader in the United States and the co-founder of the United Farm Workers of America (UFW). Her 90<sup>th</sup> birthday will be on April 10.
- The board held its annual public hearing on the Measure R Parcel Tax Plan. The plan will be adopted at the next board meeting.
- The board approved the following courses at the high school level: Automotive Technology 3, AP Computer Science Principles A, and Empowered Voices.
- The board ratified MOU Addendum #11 between SMMUSD and SMMCTA regarding a full return to in-person learning beginning April 19, 2021, for grades TK-5 and April 26, 2021, for grades 7-12 (with a distance learning-only option for those families who choose not to return for in-person learning).
