# Board of Education Regular Meeting - Thurs, October 1, 2020

# The board took action on the following:

- In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, our district has been procuring personal
  protective equipment, thermometers, and other necessary equipment. The board
  adopted a series of resolutions in March and May allowing these purchases to be
  made without the usual bidding process or pre-approval from the board. When this
  occurs, the board takes action to renew this emergency resolution, with the list of
  purchased materials attached to the agenda item.
- The board completed the superintendent's performance evaluation for 2019-20, giving Dr. Drati the highest rating in the rubric. He is entitled to an annual tax-sheltered annuity payment at the completion of his evaluation, but he waived it for 2019-20, given our district's budget issues.

### Special note:

- During his report, Dr. Drati provided a COVID-19 update, which included preliminary feedback from the distance learning survey and what our county is allowing for schools while in Tier 1. He announced that a letter would be going out explaining the community engagement process he will implement to receive feedback on the potential plans for reopening schools, once the county allows.
- The board adjourned its meeting in memory of Natividad ("Nati") Vazquez, a retired SMC Counselor and Ms. Leon-Vazquez's brother-in-law, who passed away in late September.
