Board of Education Regular Meeting - Thurs, October 15, 2020

The board took action on the following:

- The board adopted an annual resolution in honor of Week of the School Administrator, which is October 11-17, 2020, this year. This recognition celebrates our district's administrators and their dedication to the academic success and personal well-being of our students.
- In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, our district has been procuring personal protective equipment, thermometers, and other necessary equipment. The board adopted a series of resolutions in March and May allowing these purchases to be made without the usual bidding process or pre-approval from the board. When this occurs, the board takes action to renew this emergency resolution, with the list of purchased materials attached to the agenda item.
- The board approved the purchase of the office building located at 1717 4th Street in Santa Monica as the future site for our district central offices; the current location on 16th Street will be leased out as office space. The details of the purchase can be found under Item No. H.4 in the agenda.
