- Research college to determine FIT & begin creating college list
  - 9 12; balance of Safety, Target, & Reach
  - Please, please, consider colleges beyond "ranking"
- Stay productive this summer
- Follow college social media accounts, or if possible, visit during spring/summer break

## **Student-Athletes**

- Create a college list
  - all types (JC, Div 1, 2, 3), ~15 or so
- Contact coaches
  - go to clinics/showcases, pursue in-person exposure (if available)
- Create an Athletic Resume
  - list all teams you have played for
  - contact info
  - Notable achievements
- Register with NCAA Eligibility Center
