IEP Signatures:

As we move to the end of the year, please make sure that you have signed your child's IEP. The teams cannot move forward working on new goal or services without parent consent. Please contact your case manager or coordinator if you have questions about your child's IEP.

ESY:

Summer school dates on the district calendar are incorrect. Extended School Year (ESY) will run from June 23rd to July 18th, 2025. If your child qualifies for ESY you should have received forms electronically. Remember you must fill out the enrollment form as well as the transportation form. Your student is eligible for transportation if the summer school site is not your home school. Forms were due **March 21**st.

Transition Meetings:

For students matriculating to preschool, TK, kindergarten, sixth grade, or eighth grade the IEP team will be scheduling a transition meeting in the next few months. At the transition IEP meeting, the team will discuss special education classes and supports that are recommended for your student.
