Samohi Music Course Scheduling Information

The Samohi Music Program provides a creative framework in which students can find true community, make new friends, build self-confidence, make beautiful music, and have wonderful, rigorous and collaborative experiences creating music. Research has shown that students who take four years of music in high school score higher on SAT tests.* In addition, colleges tend to favor students who show four years of successful dedication to a discipline. Hopefully, this factsheet will help you navigate scheduling at the high school.

9th Grade Scheduling Options for students who want to continue music and Intro to Engineering, Avid, or a 2nd music class:

Explanation of possible scheduling options:

- 1. Take an AM class.
 - Students should see their Advisor in Spring to let them know that an AM class is desired.
- 2. Take an SMMUSD "Get Ahead" class during the summer.

- These free, full morning classes taught by Samohi teachers usually start a week after school gets out, and last six weeks. Your student still has the afternoon to go to the beach, see friends, read and relax.
- Watch the smmusd.org website and emails from Samohi for "Get Ahead" offerings. Apply IMMEDIATELY—preferably the same day—to ensure that your student will have a spot. Ask to be put on the waiting list if there are not enough spots. Often, summer plans change and spots open up.
- Incoming freshmen musicians usually take Biology, so that they can take an additional elective instead of Science. Incoming sophomores often take Chemistry or World History. Incoming juniors often take US History.
- 3. Take Independent P.E.
 - Independent PE allows students credit for advanced study in physical activities not normally available in the District's physical education program, and in which the student "has become highly competitive at a state, regional or local level." Examples include dance, gymnastics or crew, among others. 200 minutes a week, 52 hours per semester are required.
