MODIFIED MEETING PROCEDURES DURING COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS) PANDEMIC: As per Executive Order N-29-20 from Governor Newsom, the Santa Monica-Malibu Unified School District FDAC meetings will move to a virtual/teleconferencing environment using Zoom. The purpose of the Governor's executive order is to control the spread of Coronavirus (COVID-19) and to reduce and minimize the risk of infection by "limiting attendance at public assemblies, conferences, or other mass events." The Governor's executive order on March 12, 2020, already waived the requirement for a majority of members to physically participate in a public board meeting at the same location. The intent is not to limit public participation, but rather to protect public health by following the Governor's Stay at Home executive order and the LA County's Safer at Home order.

## Instructions for public comments

If you wish to make a public comment regarding an item that is scheduled for this meeting, please follow these instructions:

- a. Posted along with this agenda is a speaker request form. In order for a member of the public to address the committee, please complete the form and e-mail it to both <u>smassetti@smmusd.org</u> and <u>kstaib@smmusd.org</u> prior to the beginning of an item, and preferably prior to the beginning of the meeting. This will take the place of the "speaker chits" available at meetings.
- b. Speakers will fill in their name and select if they wish to address the committee regarding a specific agenda item or during General Public Comments.
- c. There is no physical location for this meeting. Speakers must attend the FDAC meeting through the Zoom invitation link at the top of the agenda.
- d. When it is time for the speakers to address the board, their name will be called and the microphone on their Zoom account will be activated for the allotted time. Speakers should rename their Zoom profile names to their real names to expedite this. When the allotted time for the comment has expired, the microphone for the speaker will be muted.
- e. Committee members may not engage in discussion of issues raised during "Public Comments" except to ask clarifying questions, make a brief announcement; make a brief report on his or her own activities, or to refer the matter to staff.
