<u>Instructions for public comments</u>

If you wish to make a public comment regarding an item that is scheduled for this meeting, please follow these instructions:

- a. Cards are located with meeting materials at the back of the room. Completed cards should be submitted to the Committee Chairperson prior to the beginning of an item, and preferably prior to the beginning of the meeting.
- b. Speakers will fill in their name and select if they wish to address the committee regarding a specific agenda item or during General Public Comments.
- c. This is an in-person meeting.
- d. When it is time for the speakers to address the committee, their name will be called and the microphone will be activated for the allotted time. When the allotted time for the comment has expired, the microphone for the speaker will be muted.



- e. Committee members may not engage in discussion of issues raised during "Public Comments" except to ask clarifying questions, make a brief announcement; make a brief report on his or her own activities, or to refer the matter to staff.

The Brown Act (Government Code) states that Committee members may not engage in discussion of issues raised during "Public Comments" except to ask clarifying questions, make a brief announcement; make a brief report on his or her own activities, or to refer the matter to staff. This Public Comment section is limited to 20 minutes. If the number of persons wishing to address the Committee exceeds the time limit, additional time will be allowed at the discretion of the Chair.
