We are committed to educating, connecting with, and serving our school community. Enrollment is completed by **appointment only**. Parents wishing to enroll their children can reach out to Mike Yoshioka in the Attendance Office to schedule an appointment to drop off enrollment documents.

**Our office is closed for Summer Break. We will not be doing any enrollment during our Summer Break.**

In order to begin the enrollment process, you must first prove residency within the Lincoln Middle School's boundaries.

We will require the following original documents brought with you to your appointment:

1. Verification of Parent/Guardian Identity. Photocopy of driver's license/ID card/passport.
2. Proof of residency in the Lincoln attendance area.

3. Verification of your child's birth date with a birth certificate or passport.
4. Submit complete immunization records for all students. At this time, immunizations are considered an essential medical service per the California Department of Public Health Immunization. 5. Provide a copy of your child's recent transcript, with exit grades (for mid-year enrollment).
6. Court custody paper (if joint custody).

If you do not reside within the Lincoln Middle School boundaries, you will need to apply for a permit with the district office.
