TRUSTWORTHINESS	 Is honest. Always gives best efforts. Has the courage to do the right thing. Keeps cell phone off and away in a secure location during school hours*. 	RESPECT	 Shares only positive comments with others. (Bullying & harassment will NOT be tolerated.) Uses appropriate language. Says "Please" and "Thank you." Follows directions the first time they are given. Keeps hands, feet, and objects to yourself.
RESPONSIBILITY	 Is on time and ready to learn. Comes to class prepared with all materials and homework complete. Pays attention and stays on task. Leaves electronics, slime/toys, permanent markers, gum and other prohibited/distracting items at home. 	Fairness	 Plays by the rules. Takes turns and shares. Is open-minded and listens to others. Doesn't blame others carelessly.
Caring	 Will not bully others. Will try to help students who are bullied. Will try to include students who are left out. If we know that somebody is being bullied, we will tell an adult at school and an adult at home. 	CITIZENSHIP	 Helps others; immediately notifies an adult if aware of students who may hurt themselves or others. Complies with school and classroom rules. Does not ride wheeled devices on campus and locks them in the appropriate areas. Keeps our campus clean; throws away trash.

Lincoln Middle School Dress Code

Lincoln Middle School supports a dress policy that allows students to express their individuality without creating a hostile environment for their peers. In this spirit, a Lincoln Middle School scholar who follows Dress Code:

- Wears clothing that does not depict any form of profanity, violence, drugs, alcohol, vandalism, weapons, tobacco, sexual acts, affiliation to an exclusionary group and is not offensive to any gender, race, culture, or any groups.
- Does not use hats, hoods, or any other item to conceal their face. Student faces are visible so we
 can verify they belong on our campus. Please note that hats/hoods will be confiscated or removed if
 used in a distracting way.

- Wears pants, shorts, skirts, and other clothing that ensures coverage of the entire buttocks and upper thighs at all times including when standing, sitting, kneeling or walking up and down stairs. Underwear should not be visible.
- Wears tops that do not expose their stomach, bellies, chest, lats, cleavage or mid and lower back.
 Tops are not strapless, backless, or side-less. (Racer backs and spaghetti straps are fine. Shirts that are cut lower on the sides or in the back should be worn with a tank top or camisole underneath so that the chest, stomach, side and back are not visible through the opening.)
- · Wears shoes with closed toes and heels.

Dress Code Violation Consequences: Students violating the dress code will be required to change into PE clothes. First offense is a warning. Repeated offenses will result in detention.

*Cell Phone Violation Consequences: Phone will be confiscated. First offense, student may pick up the phone from counseling office. All subsequent offenses will require a parent to pick-up the phone. Three or more offenses will result in 30-minute detention each.

**Appropriate consequences for Code of Conduct infractions will be assigned by staff and administration.
