School Resource Officer Jenkins came to campus 11.29.21 and shared the following suggestions with Principal Jessica Rishe:

- 1) The SMASH/Muir PA system will be upgraded Spring 2022. In the meantime, there are rooms and outdoor spaces where the PA announcements cannot be heard. Officer Jenkins suggests we use PA AND email AND radio announcements for now to provide multiple forms of communication
- 2) Officer Jenkins recommends keeping Search and Rescue teams of 2 together and first aid teams of 2 together. If there is an immobile injured person, S&R call for 2 first aid people to come collect the injured person and S&R continue the search together.
- 3) Keep extra copies of the campus map in our emergency command center bags. When first responders come to help we can write on there where the known hazards are, where # of students or # of adults are in danger or hurt.
- 4) Contact District Office Safety Team to update the KNOX Box on campus with the keycard for the new Salto locks.
- 5) Contact District Office Safety Team to get a keycard for the School Resource Officer

Reviewed staff reflections after fire, earthquake and lockdown drills. In addition, the team covered the “loss of utilities” and unsafe air quality procedures.
