# **Reports and Announcements** (regular agenda items)

**Principal's Report**- Construction update and Reflections on 13 out of the 39 days of in person instruction thus far

**Updates-**

- 1. Construction is progressing and exterior painting is starting this Friday
- 2. Subcontractors beginning next week to finish the new AC unit installation
- 3. Once a week meetings indicate that our timeline is on target

Five models being offered currently-

- 15 DL only students are continuing instruction with SMASH teachers
- 2 "schoolhouse" bungalows with about 50 students that we're supporting for five day a week instruction, separated into K-4 and 5-8 grades.
  - Joining with their Core when that is happening on campus
  - Joining on Zoom when those classes are offered
- Hybrid schedules
  - K/1 students Zoom in the morning and come onto the yard in the afternoons by advisory
  - 2/3/4 Zoom M, F and come ½ days on campus by advisory
  - 5/6/7/8 trade off using the baseball fields on alternate days
    - District purchased canopy chairs for student and staff use
    - Some shade tents are set up daily, parent reps asked about feasibility of putting up more. Council discussed personnel and storage needed for this.
