- Focus on goal 3 All students & families feel connected and informed...
- LCAP Goal 3 to improve climate

4 focus areas:

Reduce Absenteeism

- Did decline schoolwide by 2.6%
- Creating a sense of belonging
- Second Step
- Student perspective: (Alex likes it but some students don't)

Q Ruvolo: How do you feel about it in different classes?

• Teachers perspective: (AT) Fun to see how teachers adapt it to fit their style. Different for each. (MR) Review the norms, once they move away from each unit they move away from the norms. MR finds a lot of value in the norms.

Q Chacon: How do norms travel?

- Do it in English, but not in Spanish (FL)... (MR) exists. Next year!
- A Woldemichael: Initially students felt that it was more work, but then realized not about a grade, just participation... changed everything. Not resistant. Different personalities surfaced. Sharing. Content valuable... in math class, talking about valuing boundaries, opinions... saw in context... not linked to grades, huge plus!
- **Ruvolo:** Identity: Envisioning who they'll be in 10 years. Students found it fascinating... journey of who you are especially when you have new choices.
 - o Parents: Not so much
 - Struggling with 2 groups:
 - Struggled with ELS (27%) & LTELS (28.2%)
 - Why? Does it differ with grade level? Haven't broken down
 - Plan moving forward
 - 2 interns CR trained
 - Collaborate with the students & family services
 - Would like to have more hours 20 to 40
 - Shift focus to LTELS & ELS going forward
 - SST for attendance (SART & SARB)

Mental Health

- Climate:
 - NCS3 Teachers got foundational support for how to support with mental health (Year 1)
 - NCS3 (Year 2)
 - Teacher feedback: Really good conversations, to manage topics (FL)...
 More out of conversations than videos (MR) process time together...
 - Wrapping it up/well prepared staff. Embedded in our work next year.

Behavior & SEL

- Student Supports
 - 3 Tiers of Support (Academic & Behavioral/SEL)
 - Break down the different tiers (MC)
 - Trying to shift from emphasis on tier 3 back to tier 1 emphasis, tier 3 should be "for a few"
- Services (Grade Level Counselors)
 - Tier 1 classroom presentations for all
 - Tier 2 small groups
 - (AB) shared student experience as a 6th grader, positive
 - o Tier 3 individual check ins and referrals to health services
- Mental Health Counselor Nancy
 - *Many* responsibilities... from students to parents/families
 - May is mental health awareness month!
 - Circle for 8th grade (support transition to HS)
