Promotion Eligibility

To be eligible for the promotion, the 8th grader must meet the following criteria:

- 1. No more than two fails ("F") on the final semester report cards (January/June) combined.
- 2. No more than 500 demerits accrued.

It is also expected that students return all their textbooks, library books and chromebooks before they promote.

8th Grade Class Trip: Wednesday, June 5, 2024, 8:30am – 7:30pm at Knott's Berry Farm

This will be a full-day activity for those 8th grade students who are eligible and wish to participate. Students not attending the 8th grade event are still expected to come to school.

8th Grade Dance: Friday, June 7, 2024 (5:00 pm to 7:30 pm)

The dance will take place in the school's Performing Arts Studio supervised by administrators, teachers and parents. School dress code rules apply for the 8th grade dance. Party dress is acceptable; T-shirts and shorts are NOT recommended. Students who are not dressed appropriately will not be admitted to the dance. Admission to the dance is free. There will be food, drinks, and dessert.

Promotion Rehearsal: Tuesday, June 11, 2024, during school hours in the Performing Arts Theatre. Students will run through the entire promotion ceremony to know which teacher they are walking with for the promotion ceremony.

8th Grade Promotion Ceremony: Wednesday, June 12, 2024

1st ceremony 9:00 am - Students should arrive no later than 8:30 am.

2nd ceremony 11:30 am – Students should arrive no later than 11:00 am.

Each eligible student will receive 3 tickets to the ceremony. Closer to the event, more detailed information will be sent to families and students. At that time, extra tickets may be requested based on availability. Every guest, regardless of age, MUST have a ticket to enter the Performing Arts Theatre. This includes infants and children, even if you plan to have them sit on your lap. Seating is on a first come, first serve basis. Food, drink, balloons, banners and flowers will not be allowed inside the theatre.
