  - Doing well with English language learners (progressing almost double)
  - While the overall suspension rate seems low, the suspension rate for subgroups (African Americans, Students with Disabilities, Economically Disadvantaged) are disproportionately high → AA rate is the highest (over 10% -- 3x higher) yet a small percentage of our overall population, whereas white is the biggest pop yet not in the top suspension groups. Students with disabilities have the second highest rate of suspension (9.1)
  - Student enrollment: 9 & 12 grades increased // 10 & 11 grades decreased → Our white population increased and subgroups decreased (Overall enrollment and diversity is decreasing)
  - Number of homeless students may be undercounted
  - Can we look within subgroups for reason/suspension code?
  - What is the state rate for suspension? How does Samo compare?
