## Chromebooks in SMMUSD



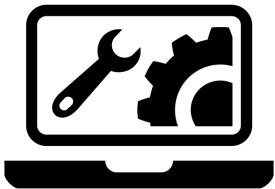
- Students need digital and online academic experiences to prepare them for their future.
